Information for Applicants

Please read this section **BEFORE** sending in your application to the Rūnanga.

INTRODUCTION

Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua provides education grants to assist students **of Ngāti Whātua descent** to attend a recognised Boarding School or to undergo tertiary study at University, Polytechnic or PTE offering “fees payable” tertiary courses. Applicants may apply for further education grants each year.

TYPES OF GRANTS AVAILABLE

1. \$300 Boarding Assistance Grants for secondary school boarders. The school **itself must be a boarding school**.
2. \$400 Tertiary Assistance Grants for students attending full-time tertiary courses.

CONDITIONS FOR RECEIVING GRANTS

ALL of the following conditions **must** be met before an education grant is approved:

1. The student **must** be registered on the Ngāti Whātua Uri Roll.
2. At least one parent (or the student him/herself) **must** be registered on the Ngāti Whātua Iwi Roll.

Note: Application forms for enrolment on the Ngāti Whātua Iwi Roll are available from the Rūnanga Office

3. Each application **must** be endorsed by any one of the 34 recognised Ngāti Whātua marae (**to which the applicant must be affiliated**), and signed by one of the following - Chairman, Secretary, Rūnanga Poupu, or a Kaumatua or Kuia of the marae.
4. Each application **must** be accompanied by **written confirmation** from the boarding school or tertiary institute that:
 - a) the **secondary** school student has been accepted or currently attending the school as a boarder, or,
 - b) the **tertiary** student has been accepted or currently enrolled on the course, the course is under way and the student is attending.
5. Each application is entitled to **ONE** education grant in each academic year.
6. Grants are recognised courses only and not for privately funded or sponsored three-day or one-week seminars and the like.

If the above conditions are not met, payment of the grant may be delayed or, the application may be declined.

PAYMENT OF GRANTS

Subject to the availability of funds, Education Grants are paid as follows:

1. \$300 is direct credited to the boarding school’s account and the school and parents are advised of the transaction. The money is credited to the students account by the school.
2. \$400 is direct-credited to the tertiary student’s bank account.

CLOSING DATE

All applications for the 2020 academic year must be received in this office by 31 July 2020, applications received after this date will not be processed.
